ACSS

The ACSS emerged out of an extensive process of research, consultations and planning conducted under the guidance of a Steering Committee composed of senior Arab scholars. Over a two-year period, from 2006 – 2008, the Steering Committee systematically examined the need for the creation for the Arab Council for the Social Sciences and developed the objectives, functions and character of the new institution. The preparatory phases of the project were generously supported by the International Development Research Centre (IDRC) of Canada and by the Ford Foundation's regional office in Cairo.
