Professor Eric Fouache is professor of physical geography and geoarchaeology at the University of Paris-Sorbonne. He was previously professor at the University of Paris Ouest – Nanterre (Paris 10) from 2008 to 2011, and at the University of Paris Est – Créteil – Val de Marne (Paris 12) from 2002 to 2008, and at the University of Paris-Sorbonne (Paris 4) from 1995 to 2002 as senior lecturer. He was chairman of the IAG working group on geoarchaeology from 2001 to 2009 and was chairman of the French Group of Geomorphology (GFG) between 2004 and 2010. He is now vice-president of the International Association of Geomorphologists (IAG) and a Senior member of the Institut Universitaire de France.

His research is concerned with geoarchaeological, palaeoenvironmental and palaeogeographical issues in the Mediterranean, the Black Sea, the Near and Middle East, and central Asia. Eric Fouache has published two books as single author and more than 100 scientific papers and book chapters, including more than 50 in international peer-reviewed journals. In 2000 and 2007, he received an award from the French “Société de Géographie” in Paris for his books.
